


GOLF CART ORDINANCE

In the interest of the health and safety of Northlake residents and visitors, Town Council amended Chapter 11 of the Town's Code of Ordinances to include Article 11.06 regarding the use of golf carts on public roadways within the Town.

OPERATIONAL REGULATIONS

- The maximum speed limit on the public street on which a golf cart is operated is thirty-five (35) miles per hour or less; golf carts shall not be operated on sidewalks, trails, or other walkways;
- While in motion, the driver and every passenger of the golf cart must be seated. No person may stand or ride in the lap of another passenger;
- Children must be properly seated while a cart is in motion. No person younger than 6 years old may be transported in a cart unless restrained by a safety belt.
- ATV's, mules, sand rails, off-highway vehicles and the like are not permitted for public roadway use in the Town.
