



**TOWN OF NORTHLAKE, TEXAS
OFFICIAL ORDINANCE**

NO. 24-0513A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTHLAKE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL UNIFORM ELECTION HELD ON MAY 4, 2024, TO ELECT A MAYOR, AND COUNCILMEMBERS TO PLACES 1, 2, AND 3; DECLARING THAT DULY ELECTED CANDIDATES RECEIVED THE MAJORITY OF VOTES CAST FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE PLACES; DECLARING NO RUNOFF ELECTION BEING NECESSARY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Town of Northlake, Texas is a Home Rule municipality located in Denton County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the General Uniform Election for the Town of Northlake, as set forth by the Texas Election Code, was held on May 4, 2024, at which time registered voters cast ballots to elect officials to the positions designated as Mayor, and Councilmember Places, 1, 2, and 3;

WHEREAS, a quorum of the Town Council, the canvassing authority, met on May 13, 2024, to duly canvass the election returns of the General Uniform Election attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTHLAKE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. All the above premises are true and correct legislative and factual findings of the Town Council, and they are hereby approved, ratified, and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.

Section 2. The May 4, 2024, General Uniform Election was duly ordered for the purpose of electing a Mayor, and Town Councilmembers to Places 1, 2, and 3; that proper notice of said election was duly given and election officials appointed; that the election was duly held and the returns of the election have been delivered to the Town Council, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the Town of Northlake.

Section 3. The official returns of the election (Exhibit A), having been opened, examined, and canvassed, show that the candidates received the following votes cast at the General Uniform Election in the Town of Northlake for a Mayor, and Councilmember Places 1 ,

2, and 3:

Section 4.

The candidates with a majority of the votes are hereby declared duly elected to the Town Council of the Town of Northlake, and shall assume the duties of their respective places for the term indicated, beginning on the date they are administered the official oath of office as follows:

Section 5.

The duly elected Mayor and Councilmembers received a majority of the votes cast at the General Uniform Election; therefore, a runoff election is not necessary.

Section 6.

The meeting at which this Ordinance was approved was open to the public and notice was given in accordance with provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551.

Section 7.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and/or publication as required by law.


