Under the 2021 budget, Northlake residents can continue to enjoy the same low municipal tax rate of over 20 years, one of the lowest in Denton County!



INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

In 2021, residents can expect to see improvements to sections of both Florance and Faught Roads, as well as improvements on Old Justin Road, road repairs within Canyon Falls and the redesign of the intersection of FM 407 and Cleveland Gibbs.

INCREASED POLICE COVERAGE

The police department will receive funding for three new positions; the addition of one detective and two additional patrol officers will allow the department to increase police presence throughout the town.



A SELF-SUSTAINING WATER SYSTEM

The recent water rate adjustment will provide funding for the construction of two elevated storage tanks and one ground storage tank totaling 2.5 million gallons of water storage, allowing the Town to provide safe, reliable water service and adequate pressure to each customer for years to come.
