## KNOW WHAT TO THROW!




### DID YOU KNOW?

When a load of recycling contains unacceptable items (such as glass, food waste, Styrofoam, plastic bags, etc.), the entire load must be taken to the landfill, meaning even the acceptable items (such as plastics numbered 1-7, steel and aluminum cans, newspapers, etc.) will not be recycled; that's why it's important to know what to throw!

### UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS



- Oil/grease containers
- Hangers
- Ovenware/Pots/Pans
- Ceramics/Plant containers
- Electronics
- Food bags
- Car parts
- Yard waste
- Furnace filters
- Paper towels and plates
- Glass of any kind (bulbs, mirrors)
- Food storage containers
- Pizza boxes
- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam
- Appliances
- Hazardous materials
- Packing peanuts
- Food waste
- Wood

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

#### FIBER (CLEAN PAPER)

- Paper
- Cardboard
- Magazines
- Newspaper
- Books
- Mail

#### PLASTICS 1-7

- Water bottles
- Soda bottles
- Salad dressing bottles
- Milk jugs
- Laundry detergent jugs
- Juice bottles

#### ALUMINUM/STEEL CANS

- Soda Cans
- Beer Cans
- Food Cans
